Hello,

Since you're in the area, I'm letting you know about our regional AMC club, the **4 Seasons Rambler Club**. We are based in New England, and local members collectively own about 200 AMC or related cars. Also, since we're a chapter of the American Motors Corp Rambler Club, all members (as of 2024) also belong to the worldwide club (aka **AMCRC**). We are open to **all years of AMC and its predecessors**, including AMC Jeep and Eagle (through Dec, 1987), Hudson, Rambler, Metropolitan, & Nash. Our 4 Seasons group has been active since 1992, and the AMCRC goes back to 1980. We have been a chapter of the **AMCRC** since December of 1995. Many of our members also belong to the AMO, the NCCA, MOCNA, and / or the H.E.T. national clubs and/or their local chapters (as well as to some non-AMC clubs).

4 Seasons members are located mostly in MA, CT, RI, ME, NH, VT, and NY. Through the 4 Seasons membership, we try to provide local access to old car news, parts, vehicle repair services, and parts identifying & cross-referencing services. The AMCRC provides a connection to an international source of information and support. Membership is renewable on a **calendar year basis** - all members receive materials for the current year, then renew by January of the next year. **For 2024, AMCRC dues increased to \$30, but that \$30 got you into both clubs.** Much of the 4 Seasons news and roster will be delivered via email if possible. The advantages of email are lower cost (to keep dues as low as possible), faster delivery, and saving hours of printing / assembly / mailing time. For 2025, I will charge \$10 more per year for USPS delivery.

Club meetings are informal. We hold a post-Christmas holiday party in January, an annual lunch gathering the Sunday following Easter, a season kickoff meeting & cookout the first Sunday in June, and we host a regional show in July (next one is the last weekend in July Boxboro MA). Other meetings, shows, cookouts, and activities are scheduled as the need or interest arises, and are held in various central New England locations. All are posted in our newsletter. Friends and family (bring kids, grandkids, parents, and/or grandparents) are welcome at any of the meetings, shows, or gatherings.
